Notice to Registrants

Re: Liquid Rhinoplasty

The College advises that, effective January 1, 2021, registrants will not be permitted to perform the liquid rhinoplasty procedure on patients, including registrants that are certified by the College in [aesthetic procedures](#). The College also advises registrants to ensure that their advertising and marketing materials are amended to remove liquid rhinoplasty as an available procedure.

The College has a legal mandate to protect the public. The College made the decision to not permit liquid rhinoplasty to be performed by registrants because of the serious side effects and risks associated with the procedure. These side effects and risks can include vascular necrosis, blindness, and stroke. Further, registrants do not have the ability to refer patients directly to a medical specialist in the event of an emergency when performing the liquid rhinoplasty procedure.
